Guidelines regarding abstract submission for the symposium

1. General instructions

- a. Registration for the symposium is mandatory for submission.
- b. You will need to enter the registration ID on the abstract submission link.
- c. Abstract submission is via the link on the symposium brochure.
- d. Abstracts should be submitted in a structured format, under any of the categories listed below.
- e. The abstract will be published in the symposium souvenir

2. Important dates

- a. Abstract submission starts: 10th October 2024
- b. Abstract submission last date: 31st October 2024
- c. Abstract acceptance result intimation: 10th November 2024

3. Flow chart for the registration and abstract submission process

- a. Registration for the symposium
 - i. Pay the registration amount via the QR code provided
 - ii. Note the transaction ID
 - iii. Register for the symposium via the link provided (mention the transaction ID in the registration form)
 - iv. You will receive an email for the registration confirmation with registration ID

b. Abstract submission link

- i. Please click on the abstract submission link
- ii. Enter the registration ID and submit the abstract as mentioned in the abstract layout/ format

4. Abstract layout/ format

- a. Abstract title
 - i. The abstract title is restricted to 50 words.
 - ii. The title of the abstract must be concise. Please do not use abbreviations.
- b. Corresponding Author details with affiliation
- c. Co-Author details with affiliation
 - i. Do not use prefixes/titles of author/co-authors.

d. Abstract

- i. The abstract must be submitted in English.
- ii. Abstract content is restricted to 500 words. Do not include graphs/tables/images/references in the abstract.
- iii. Abstract content must have headings as below: Introduction, Aims & Objective, Materials & Methods, Results, Conclusion
- iv. Do not mention the name of the institute or the name of the authors in the abstract body.
- e. Select the abstract presentation type (Oral/ Poster/ Either)
- f. The scientific committee reserves the right to accept/reject/assign presentation type to the abstract.
- g. Notification regarding acceptance of the submission along with the guidelines for presentation will be sent to the corresponding author's e-mail.
